

# Horse Safety Survey

#### 2022 Results

### **About the Survey**

In October of 2022 the Dude Ranchers' Association and Dude Ranch Foundation administered a survey to DRA member ranches, of which 72 ranches answered questions regarding the type, number and seriousness of injuries sustained to their guests during the 2022 season.

The results show a 'good report card' for the dude ranch industry. There was a total of **702,784 hours** in the saddle for the ranches who answered the survey.

156 injuries required medical attention from a total of 105,455 guests. That is a rate of injury much less than half of 1 percent of the number of all guests reported at 0.15%.


